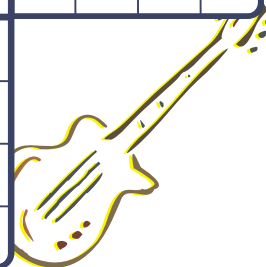
Can you figure out which instrument each student plays and which language each one is learning?
